Week 1 (W1)

Black bin: Anything that cannot be recycled.

Blue box: Paper e.g. newspapers, magazines, telephone directories.

Week 2 (W2)

Green bin: Food and garden waste.

Brown bin/black box: Glass, cartons, plastics, cans and cardboard.



Public holidays All collections in a week following a public holiday will take place a day later. For example, a Monday collection will take place on Tuesday and a Friday collection will take place on Saturday, unless you are notified otherwise. You will be advised of changes to Christmas and New Year collections nearer the time.

Did you know that Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) can be recycled at some of our local recycling sites?

You can recycle anything with a plug or batteries that will fit in the chute of the bank*. For example cameras, hairdryers, irons, kettles, power tools, laptops, toys, lamps, fairy lights etc.

There is also a separate section for domestic batteries in the top right-hand corner of each bank.
