Week 1 (W1)

Black bin: Anything that cannot be recycled.

Blue box: Paper e.g. newspapers, magazines, telephone directories.

Week 2 (W2)

Green bin: Food and garden waste.

Brown bin/black box: Glass, cartons, plastics, cans and cardboard.

Public holidays All collections in a week following a public holiday will take place a day later. For example, a Monday collection will take place on Tuesday and a Friday collection will take place on Saturday, unless you are notified otherwise. You will be advised of changes to Christmas and New Year collections nearer the time. A new calendar for 2015 will be issued with the winter edition of Hertsmere News.
