

Thameslink Route

This is a general guide to the basic daily service. Not all trains stop at all stations on each coloured line; please check the timetable.

Thameslink routes are shown in four different colours to help identify the general pattern; see below for details.

6 Bedford and Brighton

- Until 19 December 2014, trains serve Blackfriars and London Bridge with some peak trains serving Elephant & Castle and not London Bridge
- From 20 December 2014, there will be no direct service between Blackfriars and London Bridge. Trains through Central London will serve Elephant & Castle not London Bridge

7 Luton, Wimbledon and Sutton

- Trains run anticlockwise around the Wimbledon loop and continue on route 8

8 St Albans, Mitcham and Sutton

- Trains run clockwise around the Wimbledon loop and continue on route 7
- No Sunday service north of London Blackfriars

9 Kent

- Some peak hour trains also serve stations to and from Bedford and/or other destinations in Kent
- Trains on Saturdays and Sundays do not operate north of London Blackfriars
- Until 19 December 2014, trains on this route are operated by Southeastern south of London Blackfriars
